
Sir:

The Bureau acknowledges your letter of 15 January 1938 together with your blueprints received under separate cover.

If you desire the Bureau to examine fully the merits of your cryptographic device, it will be necessary for you to provide a complete description of the device wherein reference is made to identifying symbols, which should be added to your blueprints to designate the various parts of the device. This description should include a step-by-step analysis of the operation of the device during encipherment and during decipherment, with particular reference to the manner in which decipherment is accomplished.
